Father P. J. Mullane - 57 Chamberlain Ave. Point of Pine
Born in St. Elizabeth Hospital - Dr. Thos Scanlon, obstetric
mother went to hospital in 7th mo. - toxemia
they gave no hope for baby.
Child born 3 wks premature - five on delivery - no force
wt. 4½ lbs. - nursed for 2 days - then fed in dropper
had one bad spell in hospital - mother had phlebitis -
came home with child at end of 4th - or 5th week.
Bottle feeding - Dextrin Maltose -
child liked best to be supported in upright position -
circumcised at 8 mos.
Lifted head but could not sit up - slumped in high chair.
At one year took child to Dr. Martin English - given calcein
tablets for Tetany. also massaged in sweet oil. Improve
Went to Childrens Hospital. saw Dr. Guest. Said toxemia of
mother had produced condition and that it would gradual
improve. Went to Dr. W. W. Howell in fall of 1929.
Sent to me for posture work Nov. 1929.
